

CMA Standardised Price List

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (Funeral Director's charges only) **£2,050.00**

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as their burial or cremation.

-Taking care of all the necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£950.00
-Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral directors premises) into the funeral directors care	£150.00
-Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities.	
-The deceased person will be kept at the Funeral Directors M G Evans, Long Street, Atherstone, CV9 1AX	£165.00
-Providing a suitable coffin- this will be made from Oak Veneer	£535.00
-Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral directors (where viewing is requested by the customer within working hours)	£50.00
-At a date and time, you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£200.00

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

-This is a Funeral where the family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not wish to attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (funeral directors charges only)	£1000.00
Cremation (funeral directors charges plus the cremation fee)	£1,500.00

FEES YOU MUST PAY (Third-Party Costs)

-For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee Atherstone Council*	£790.00
-In this local area, the typical cost of a burial for local residents is	£790.00
<i>For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.</i>	
-For an attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee at the Heart of England Crematorium*	£1070.00
-In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for a local resident is:	£1070.00

**This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.*

*** In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.*
